SQUASH

We have made some additional amendments to the squash court booking system, all in the interests of giving each member an even chance of booking courts. The major changes are the following:

1. There is now a limit to the length of time an individual member can book a court in to the future. This is currently set at 2 weeks.
2. It is now impossible to book 2 courts under your own name at the same time. It is physically not possible for you to be playing on 2 courts at the same time. If you are booking two courts because 4 members are playing together, then one of the other members must book that other court.
3. Each member is now able to use a set number of time slots to play with a guest, for free, per month. The allocation for this is currently set at four free guest time slots, but these free guest slots are likely to be reduced in the near future. You may choose to invoke this option when you are booking to play with a guest. If you exceed the free guest slots in a month, then you will be charged the guest fee (R20) for each subsequent guest you bring in. You are reminded of the Club policy that any guest that you bring in to the Club (even if it is to play on one of your 'free' guest slots) **MUST** be signed in to the Club by you. I ask you to please adhere to this policy. These free guest slots will be reset at the beginning of each month.
4. We shall be changing all courts in due course to be 45 minutes slots

In addition, the water fountains are now up and working well. The old water fountains have been removed, so you are advised to carry a water bottle with you in your squash bag.

Also, the clocks are now installed, and are being synchronized to the timing system. A third clock is on order to be placed between courts 5 and 6. That will be installed in due course.

I would welcome any feedback on these amendments, both to the booking system and the general facilities around the courts.
