MEMBERSHIP CARDS AND DARK SOLED SHOES

You are reminded to furnish your membership cards when playing on the courts. In addition, there are some tell-tale marks on the courts, indicating dark soled shoes have been used. Please ensure you are wearing the correct shoes to play. If you are not sure, ask the Duty Manager, or at reception. We carry spare shoes in this event, so there is no reason why anyone should be wearing dark-soled shoes on the courts. Our floors are untreated, in order to provide the best playing conditions. However, this does make them susceptible to marking, so please ensure you are wearing the correct shoes.

COURT USAGE – UPCOMING TOURNAMENTS

From a court usage perspective, we are heading in to our busy period for the next 6 weeks. The courts are going to be fairly heavily utilized, and I ask all members for their patience during this period. All the tournaments will involve WPCC members to varying degrees, and most of the tournaments will feature high-quality squash. You are invited to come down to the courts and watch and support the squash that will be played. This coming week, in particular, is the WP Closed, which is used as part of the ranking process for selection of our provincial teams.
