## SQUASH

The major development over the last few weeks has been the renovations to our courts. As was detailed in an email to all squash players last week, this has taken longer than anticipated. However, I have it on firm authority that the courts will be completed by the end of this week, and we will be back to normal by next week. Our courts should then be as good as new, as we have also completed additional minor work during this period, such as refilling the front walls, and straightening the glass walls at the back. Once the dust has settled (literally!), we look forward to many years of pristine courts.

To celebrate the re-opening of the courts, we will be holding a Flash Squash Tournament on Friday the 29th of July, from 6:00pm to 8:30pm. All members, across all playing standards, are urged to enter. First come, first served! ### How does a Flash Squash Tournament work?

Each of the 3 tournament divisions are open to the first 21 players to sign up. Then players in each division are split into 3 separate groups according to level, and each group has one member of the Pro U23 squad placed into it – so there are 8 players in each group in total. Over the 2 ½ hours, players play everyone in their group one game, P-A-R scoring to 15 points, or 11 points, depending on level. Every point you score counts towards your final total and the player with the most points in each group (excluding the pro player) wins a great prize from the evenings sponsor, Harrow. Flash squash is fun and very active – you play 7 games in total, including the one against the pro, and you will be kept busy for the whole time period as when you are not playing you are refereeing one of the other matches in your group.
