



Western Province Cricket Club - Reciprocal Rights

The Trust is pleased to offer a reciprocal arrangement between Western Province Cricket Club and the Sydney Cricket Ground (SCG), Sydney, Australia.

Test Match, One Day International, AFL, BBL and selected NRL matches at the SCG.

Tickets will be available for each scheduled event at the SCG. Ticket prices (adult and junior) are applicable and will be advised closer to each event. Children under the age of 5 years do not require a ticket. Please [Click here](#) to see the current events on offer for reciprocal Members.

Eligibility:

1. Western Province Cricket Club Members can purchase a Member day pass for themselves and one for a guest.
2. Day passes to be purchased at the nominated fee. Please check the website for ticket prices and events.
3. Western Province Cricket Club Members can access all areas of the Ladies Pavilion and MA Noble Stand.
4. Members wishing to enjoy SCG facilities must be on a short visit to Sydney and must not reside permanently or even for an indefinite period in Australia. Proof of residence and a letter of introduction from the relevant Membership department are required at the time of ticket collection/entry.
5. Members are entitled to introduce a guest per day at the relevant charge. This is limited to one guest of the Member who must also be on a short visit to Sydney. Reciprocal privileges are restricted to Members and their guest only.

Ticket payment and collection:

Members must attend the Match Day Office on game day to purchase and collect tickets. The Match Day Office is located at the SCG Members Entrance Gate A on Driver Avenue.

Sydney Cricket Ground Members Reserve:

The SCG Members Reserve includes the Ladies Pavilion, Members Pavilion, MA Noble and Don Bradman stands. Seating for reciprocal Members is unreserved.

While visiting the Sydney Cricket Ground we require reciprocal Members to dress in a manner that reflects the dignity and traditions of the Members Reserve. Neat, smart casual attire must be worn at all times. No revealing, unclean or untidy clothing or footwear is permitted. Members and their guests will be denied admission to the Members Reserve if they do not meet these requirements.

Sydney Cricket Ground rules and regulations, particularly those relating to dress and behaviour must be observed by all persons in all areas of the Members' Reserve and Pavilion. A strict dress code is to be followed Please [Click here](#) to view.

MEMBERS' CONDUCT

Members, Guests and Members from reciprocal rights venues are requested to observe a standard of behaviour.

We ask that Members and Guests are courteous and considerate of their fellow Members by limiting their movement whilst a match is in progress. This is particularly important during an over and Members should remain seated until the over is completed. If Members desire the benefit of a hand held radio we would ask that they use an earpiece. We also ask Members using mobile phones to do so where possible away from spectator viewing areas.
