Notes:

1. The official club shirt is to be worn in semis and finals of WPBA, All Cape, WPCC and BSA Competitions.
2. For club selected competitions, the official club shirt is to be worn and only club or white caps, hats or peaks are to be worn.
3. Individual players in a team may wear white or blue trousers/shorts, but the whole team must wear the same colour.
4. *indicates or equivalent long sleeve shirt, while **indicates other shirts and team kits may be worn in club selected competitions of more than 1 consecutive day, if approved by the Chairperson or Vice-chairpersons.
5. Footwear: Only acceptable flat-soled shoes/sandals (with backstrap) may be worn.
6. Belts: White or navy belts to be worn when belts are required.

Notes:

1. When playing on the same green as a WPBA competition, dress code must be the same as for WPBA competitions above. (* or equivalent long sleeve shirt.)
2. If a member is dressed inappropriately for tabs-in, the duty officer should point this out to the member but not turn the member away. If any member persists in not complying with the dress code, then this matter will be addressed by the culture and disciplinary sub-committee.

GENERAL RULES	The following items are not permitted as Mufti: T-shirts (any shirt without a collar), running shorts, leggings, cargo pants and faded jeans.
DRESS CODE during OPEN SEASON (summer)	Mufti may not be worn to tabs-in on Wednesday and Saturdays. Mufti may be worn for Sunday tabs-in. Mufti may be worn for practice any time of the day on a green not being used by WPBA.
DRESS CODE during CLOSED SEASON (winter)	Mufti may be worn for all games. The club leaves the mufti dress code to the members. Whatever is worn, ensure that the clothing is clean and neat.
NEW CLUB CLOTHING	Any new or amended official club clothing must be approved by the bowls committee.
